

## 13<sup>th</sup> International Colloquium on Late and Vulgar Latin (*Latin vulgaire – latin tardif XIII*)

### First announcement and Call for Papers

The colloquia *Latin vulgaire – Latin tardif* (Colloque international sur le Latin Vulgaire et Latin Tardif – International Colloquium on Late and Vulgar Latin) have been held continuously for more than three decades. After Pécs (1985), Bologna (1988), Innsbruck (1991), Caen (1994), Heidelberg (1997), Helsinki (2000), Sevilla (2003), Oxford (2006), Lyon (2009), Bergamo (2012), Oviedo (2014) and Uppsala (2016) – now it is time for Budapest (2018).

The 13th International Colloquium on Late and Vulgar Latin (*Latin vulgaire – latin tardif XIII*) will be held at the Faculty of Humanities of the Eötvös Loránd University, Budapest, Hungary, from Monday, September 3rd to Friday, September 7th, 2018. It will be organized by the Latin Department of the Institute of Ancient and Classical Studies of the Eötvös Loránd University in collaboration with the 'Momentum' Research Group for Computational Latin Dialectology at the Research Institute for Linguistics of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. The Colloquium of Budapest 2018 will be dedicated to the memory of József Herman who organized the first Colloque international sur le Latin Vulgaire et Latin Tardif (*Latin vulgaire – latin tardif I*) in Pécs, Hungary 1985.

The colloquium will start on Monday late afternoon, September 3rd (opening session, welcome reception). The papers will be presented in plenary and parallel sessions from Tuesday, September 4th through to Friday, September 7th (closing session in the afternoon). There will be an excursion one afternoon (Wednesday or Thursday) during the colloquium and possibly, if a sufficient number of participants are interested, a longer one on Saturday 8th. The conference dinner will take place on Thursday (September 6th) evening.

The colloquium will be held in English, French, German, Spanish, Italian and Latin. It will be devoted to all linguistic aspects of Late and Vulgar Latin (including the transition from Latin to Romance). As per usual, papers will be limited to 30 minutes (including questions), meaning there will be 20 minutes for each paper, followed by a discussion of 10 minutes. A peer reviewed selection of papers will be published in a special issue of the journal *Acta Antiqua Academiae Scientiarum Hungaricae*.

If there is enough interest, one or more workshops on selected topics can be organized.

**The deadlines are:**

- for indicating interest in participation and submitting a preliminary paper title: **September 15st 2017.**
- for final paper titles and abstracts (maximum 1 page including bibliography): January 1st 2018.
- a notice of acceptance or rejection of abstracts will be given by: March 1st 2018.

A call for registration will be sent out in March 2018.
