

Third announcement and Call for Registration

1. REGISTRATION: All of you who have sent in an abstract will have been notified by now whether or not their paper has been accepted. If not, please contact us. **We would like to inform you that registration is open now at our website:** <http://lvlt13.elte.hu/index.php/registration/>. The content of the registration site is password protected. To view it please enter the password you got by email in the respective field of the aforementioned website. We recommend that you carefully read the registration terms there before filling in the registration. Your registration will be validated once you have filled out and submitted the registration form by June, 1st 2018. **The deadline for registration is June, 1st.** After this date if you wish to register you will need to request registration by email and as numbers are limited we cannot guarantee acceptance. If you have a co-author, please inform him/her about this mail.

2. HERMAN AWARD: In memory of József Herman (1924–2005) his widow Marianne Bakró-Nagy and the Comité international pour l'étude du latin vulgaire et tardif have established a prize for the best contribution by a young researcher at the biennial International Colloquium on Late and Vulgar Latin – Latin vulgaire – latin tardif. 3. PRELIMINARY PROGRAM: The preliminary program, for now scheduled for 96 papers looks as follows. The colloquium will start on Monday afternoon, at 5 p.m., September 3rd in the Lapidarium of the Hungarian National Museum (opening session, welcome reception). The papers will be presented in plenary and parallel sessions from Tuesday, September 4th to Friday, September 7th in Building F of the Faculty of Humanities, Eötvös Loránd University Budapest (with the closing session on Friday afternoon in Building A, ending ca. 4:15 p.m.). There will be an excursion to Aquincum Museum and Archaeological Park on Wednesday afternoon (and possibly, if a sufficient number of participants is interested, a longer one on Saturday 8th). The conference dinner will be held on Thursday evening (September 6th). The closed session of the Comité international pour l'étude du latin vulgaire et tardif is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. Thursday.
