

13th International Colloquium on Late and Vulgar Latin (*Latin vulgaire – latin tardif XIII*)

Dear colleagues,

Please find below important information concerning organisation of the colloquium.

PROGRAMME: We are pleased to inform you that the detailed final programme of the 13th International Colloquium on Late and Vulgar Latin is available on the website together with all the abstracts. See <http://lvlt13.elte.hu/index.php/latest-news/> or <http://lvlt13.elte.hu/index.php/program/>. You will receive printouts from the conference desk, so you need not print it yourself.

START: The colloquium will start on Monday afternoon, at **17:00**, September 3rd in the Lapidarium of the Hungarian National Museum (opening session, welcome reception). See <http://lvlt13.elte.hu/index.php/venue/>. You can go to the venue by yourself, or with the group: Departure from Building F of the Faculty of Humanities, Eötvös Loránd University, Budapest, Múzeum körút 4. at **16:40** (see the map on the last page of the Programme and at <http://lvlt13.elte.hu/index.php/venue/>). If you have registered for the opening session and welcome reception on Monday afternoon, but you know you will arrive too late to take your conference bag normally available at the conference desk in Building F of the Faculty until 16:45, you can get it at the Lapidarium of the Hungarian National Museum during the opening session. For that, please let us know in an email sent to lvlt13@btk.elte.hu by Sunday evening, September 2nd (otherwise you can get your conference bag only on Tuesday morning).

CONFERENCE DESK: The conference desk will be located in front of the Kerényi room on the ground floor of Building F. It will open at **14:00** on Monday, September 3rd (that day it closes at **16:45**). Here you will get the definitive programme, the book of abstracts, various vouchers and all other information you need. During the congress the reception desk will be open all day for further questions and information.

TRAVEL INFORMATION: At the website of LVL 13 we posted important information on travel options and conditions of public transport in Budapest, considering the conference venue, the airport and the railway stations of Budapest (important note: Citizens of Hungary, other EU and EEA Member States or Switzerland aged 65+ travel for free see <http://lvlt13.elte.hu/index.php/2017/11/21/travel-information/>). As you will probably spend several days in Budapest, it might be worth buying a weekly pass or a block of tickets. The city is big, attractions are quite scattered and far from each other, and the excursion to Aquincum Museum and Archaeological Park will be done by public transport (by metro line no. M2 and suburban railway line no. H5, needing at least 4 tickets to ride there and back to the city centre).

PRESENTATIONS: Presentations are limited to 20 min. of talk + 8 min. of discussion (in plenary sessions, to 40 min. + 10 min. of discussion). In order to guarantee linking of individual presentations, it is absolutely necessary that everyone respects the allocated time. Chair persons of sessions will ensure that schedule is respected and will indicate you the time

that remains (5 min. / 1 min. / 0 min. = stop). Speakers must follow their instructions. A speaker who consumes all the time of his/her slot will have no discussion.

POWERPOINT: If you have a powerpoint presentation, your document has to be downloaded in the computer of the room where your presentation will have take place **BEFORE** the beginning of the whole **SESSION**. E.g. if your paper is scheduled for 12:30, your powerpoint document has to be ready in the computer before 11.00. Please check that it works correctly.

HANDOUTS: Please bring a sufficient number of copies of your handout with you. The organizers cannot provide copying service.

WIFI ACCESS: At the conference venue (on the campus of the Faculty of Humanities), you will have free WIFI access during the conference. The network to access is LVL13, you can access it with the password Herman1924.
